WELLNESS POLICY

We at Pinnacle Academic College care about our community and want to ensure the safety of everyone. Sick children and adults need to stay in their homes to better recover quickly and completely, this protects them and the wider community.

In order to ensure the safety of our Staff and Students, we require the following:

- Any adult or student or unenrolled child who is showing obvious signs of illness NOT to attend PAC activities including On Campus Drop Off/Pick Up, On Campus Classes and PAC Days.
- Any adult or student or unenrolled child who has been unwell to be clear of **all** symptoms for 48 hours before again attending any PAC activities including On Campus Drop Off/Pick Up, On Campus Classes and PAC Days.
- We would like to bring your attention specifically to vomiting and diarrhea, please keep your child home for 48 hours after their last loose bowel movement and/or vomit. If gastro is actively going through your family, we ask that your child/ren stay home until everyone in your household is 48 hours clear of illness.

We thank you for your co-operation in this to help keep our College community as well as the wider community safe and healthy.
